

**McGuffey Back to School Supplies Fall 2011**  
**Grades K/1/2**

**Community Items Grades K/1/2 (Please do not label as these items will be contributed to the classroom supplies):**

- 1 pack of 8 count Crayola Washable Broadline Markers Classic Colors
- 1 pack 50 count Supertip Crayola Washable Markers
- 1 box 24 count crayons
- 1 box colored pencils
- 2 pack #2 pencils w/erasers
- 1 pack pink pearl type erasers
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors
- 2 small glue sticks
- 1 small bottle of white school glue
- 5 three-prong paper folders with pockets (red, blue, green, purple, yellow)
- 2 three-prong plastic folders with pockets (orange)
- 1 four-pack of odorless dry erase markers
- 1 large container of Clorox Green Works Natural Biodegradable Cleaning Wipes
- 1 box “baby” wipes
- 1 pencil box
- 1 box each of gallon and quart-size freezer-weight Ziplocs
- 1 composition book for science
- 1 simple pocket folder, no internal brads, labeled

**Personal items (Please do LABEL these items with your child’s name):**

- Lunchbox or bag labeled with the child’s name.
- 4 spiral-bound notebooks
- 2 composition books (science & math)
- Simple pocket folder, no internal brads, labeled (science)
- Backpack labeled on the inside (see below)
- A lunchbox or bag labeled with the child’s name

**Kindergarten only:**

Complete change of clothing including 2 pairs of underwear and socks in a plastic Ziploc bag. Please label each item AND the bag. Please change out the clothing when the seasons change!

**SUPPLY NOTES for K/1/2 parents:**

1. **Choosing a Backpack:** Each student needs a backpack to bring back and forth to school each day. Backpacks should have closures that can be easily managed by the student and be large enough to hold a 9” x 12” folder, drawing, pouch or book without destroying it. They need to hang from a hook in the locker room. We have found that those of relatively “soft” durable fabric and an “unstructured” design work best. **NO WHEELS PLEASE!**
2. Please use a permanent marker to **LABEL** every single thing your child could possibly wear or bring to school. Please **DO** label all new, old, or handed-down clothing and clearly identify other things (books, shells, vacation souvenirs etc.) If the item comes to school in a Ziploc bag, please also label the bag!
