

McGuffey Back to School Supplies Fall 2011
Grades 3/4/5/6

Community Items Grades 3/4 (Please do not label as these items will be contributed to the classroom supplies):

- 1 quart size box of freezer-weight Ziplocs
- 1 container of Clorox Green Works Natural Biodegradable Cleaning Wipes (only that brand)
- 1 package pink pearl type erasers

Personal Items Grades 3/4 (Please do LABEL these items with your child's name):

- Backpack or schoolbag – not big and no wheels
 - A lunchbox or bag labeled with the child's name
 - 2 simple pocket folders, no internal brads, labeled
 - 2 composition notebooks (science, math)
 - 1 pack fine-tipped water-based markers
 - Colored pencils (20-24 pack for SS)
 - One or two fine-line black markers (water based)
 - 1 pack #2 pencils w/erasers pencils (will need to be replenished as needed)

Community Items Grades 5/6 (Please do not label as these items will be contributed to the classroom supplies):

- 1 gallon size box of Ziplocs
- 1 container of Clorox Green Works Natural Biodegradable Cleaning Wipes (only that brand)
- 1 pack pencil top erasers

Personal items Grades 5/6 (Please do LABEL these items with your child's name):

- Backpack or schoolbag – not big and no wheels, please label on the inside.
- A lunchbox or bag labeled with the child's name
- 3 pocket folders (LA, science, social studies)
- 2 composition notebooks (science, math)
- 1-inch simple vinyl-covered binder
- 1 pencil bag for inside binder (3-hole punched)
- 1 pack fine-tipped water-based markers
- Colored pencils (20-24 pack for SS)
- Two fine-line black markers (water based)
- 1 pack #7 mechanical pencils with replacement lead
- Erasers and pencil top erasers if bringing standard pencils
- Small **flash drive**, doesn't need a ton of memory (to transport some homework and e-projects)

*****Required for grade 6: a scientific calculator (preferably solar and battery powered such as a Casio F-300 MS Plus, not a graphing one. Please contact Marcia if you have any questions. You must must must save the direction booklet!**

SUPPLY NOTES for 3/4/5/6 parents:

1. **Choosing a Backpack:** Please choose one large enough to accommodate daily belongings but not so large that it is unwieldy to carry and store at school. They need to hang from a hook in the locker room. Ones made of relatively durable fabric and an unstructured design work the best and can last several years. **NO WHEELS PLEASE!** Please label backpacks on the inside.
2. Please use a permanent marker to **LABEL** every single thing your child could possibly wear or bring to school. Please **DO** label all new, old, or handed-down clothing and clearly identify other things (books, shells, vacation souvenirs etc.) If the item comes to school in a Ziploc bag, please also label the bag!
